

Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP)

Kern Family Health Care (KFHC) is offering DPP to KFHC members at risk of diabetes. DPP is designed to prevent or delay type 2 diabetes. This is a one-year program that includes:

- 1. Classes and one-on-one support with a lifestyle coach.
- 2. Support groups of members with prediabetes.
- 3. Up to \$410 in gift cards for attending classes and reaching goals.
- 4. Classes offered in person at the KFHC office and via Zoom.

You may be eligible for DPP if you meet <u>all</u> the following:

- 1. Are 18 years or older.
- 2. Are overweight.
- 3. Have been diagnosed with prediabetes or tested positive on the Prediabetes Risk Test.
- 4. Don't have diabetes and are not pregnant.
